## **How to Write a Strong Application**

# 1. Clearly Define Your Shopfront Improvement Plans

A strong application starts with a well-thought-out plan. Ask yourself:

- What improvements do you plan to make? (e.g., repainting, installing new signage, upgrading window displays, adding planters)
- How will these improvements enhance your shop's appearance and attract more customers?
- How do the improvements contribute to a more inviting town centre?

Tip: The more specific your application, the better. Instead of just saying, "We will improve our shopfront," explain how—e.g., "We will repaint the exterior in a fresh, welcoming colour and install a new sign with modern, easy-to-read lettering."

#### 2. Provide a Detailed Cost Breakdown

Your budget should be **clear and justified**. A weak application will list vague costs (e.g., "Shopfront improvements - £1,000"), whereas a strong application will provide a breakdown:

- **✓ Painting & materials:** £200
- **√** New signage: £600
- **✓ Decorative elements** (new lighting): £200

**Tip:** Discover Halifax will **match up to £500** of your total cost, but you **must contribute at least 50% of the total cost** yourself. Ensure your budget aligns with this requirement.

# 3. Include Supporting Documents

To strengthen your application, **provide evidence** of your planned improvements, such as:

- ✓ At least **one quote** from a contractor or supplier
- ✓ Photos of your **current shopfront** (before improvements)
- ✓ A rough sketch or **mock-up** of the proposed changes (*if applicable*)
- Tip: Applications without supporting documents may be delayed or rejected.

  Providing clear documentation helps demonstrate your commitment and planning.

# 4. Ensure Your Application Meets the Fund's Criteria

Your improvements must:

- ▼ Focus on **external shopfront enhancements** (internal upgrades are not eligible)
- Be completed within 3 months of approval
- Align with **Discover Halifax's** goal of making the town centre **more attractive and** vibrant

# ★ Example of a strong application:

"Our café's signage is outdated and difficult to read. We plan to install a modern, well-lit sign (£600) and repaint the exterior in warm, inviting colours (£400). These changes will improve visibility, attract more foot traffic, and contribute to a more visually appealing high street. We have attached a supplier quote and a mock-up of the new sign. We are ready to proceed upon approval and expect completion within eight weeks."

## What Happens After Approval?

If your application is successful:

- You must complete the improvements within 3 months.
- Funding is provided upon approval. However, as part of the agreement, you will need to submit the following after completion to ensure funds have been utilised correctly:
  - **Photos** of the completed work
  - Receipts/invoices from suppliers or contractors

Tip: Discover Halifax will feature your shopfront improvements on **social media and** in **marketing materials** to showcase the positive impact of the fund while also promoting your business.

# **Final Checklist Before Submitting**

- ✓ Have you clearly described your shopfront improvements?
- ✓ Have you provided a **detailed budget breakdown**?
- ✓ Have you attached at least one supplier quote?
- ☑ Have you ensured your improvements align with the **fund's objectives**?
- Once your application is ready, submit it online via the application form. If you need help, we're here to support you throughout the process.
